"Is Christianity Less Honest than Science?" Monday, June 18 @ 7 PM at Wolfville Baptist Church - 487 Main St., Wolfville, NS In light of modern science, atheists like Richard Dawkins accuse Christians of being dishonest. Instead of looking at evidence, he says, religious people already have their conclusions "in advance" from a "holy book," and any new evidence will always be automatically dismissed. Is Dawkins's objection valid? Is there something intellectually dishonest about Christian faith? This talk answers Dawkins by explaining how Christians can be intellectually honest toward both God and scientific inquiry.
