**Indigenous History Month:** The Mi'kmaq are a First Nations North American people indigenous to northeastern New England, the Atlantic Provinces and Gaspé Peninsula. The word Mi'kmaq means "allies." The Mi'kmaq are a peaceful and welcoming people. In 1610, Chief Membertou concluded the first alliance with Europeans, a concordat with French Jesuits that affirmed the right of the Mi'kmaq to choose Catholicism, Mi'kmaq tradition or both. Between 1725 - 1779, the Mi'kmaq signed a series of peace and friendship treaties with Great Britain but none of these were land session treaties, thus we are all living on Mi'kmaq territorial land.
